Getting to Paradise Coast Sports Complex:

We are located off Collier Blvd. (SR 951), 1/4 mile North of I-75 (Exit 101)

- The Complex has North and South entry points
- All external fields can be accessed from both sides of the facility
- The main stadium parking lot is on the South side

Arriving:

- No outside Food or Beverage is permitted inside the Complex
- Pay attention to which lot you have parked in
- Leave coolers and large bags in your car
- Enter through open and or manned gates
- If a gate is locked do not attempt to enter or climb fences (see policies below)

For your safety:

- Drinking fountains are available around the facility
- Iced water is available for all athletes
- Most tournament events are staffed with certified athletic trainers
- AED's are located at every building at the Complex

Be aware of the weather conditions:

- Hot weather is typical in Florida; stay hydrated and wear sunscreen
- Dangerous weather is also common. Pay attention to the conditions and be ready to evacuate to your vehicle immediately if the weather system sounds.
